

Get local veg into school or work



Sign up now for a truly local vegetable bag scheme which helps you eat your 5-a-day, supports local farmers and raises money for your school, or chosen workplace charity.

Brighton-based food delivery company, We Love Local, are now able to supply bags of fantastic seasonal vegetables, grown locally, to your school or workplace every week.

Why buy local veg?

Buying local veg supports farmers in the region who struggle to make any money from traditional contracts with supermarkets. We pay them a fair price - over 40% of the price of your bag goes directly to the farmer. This helps farmers to keep the surrounding countryside looking lovely and preserve traditional varieties of British veg.

Buying local also keeps food miles down and lorries off the road. When you participate in a veg bag scheme, we can deliver to lots of you in one drop in our little van, which is powered by bio-diesel.

How does it work?

You get people signed up at school or work to take a regular vegetable bag, which is then delivered to you weekly at your school or workplace.

How do you order & pay?

Work out the number of bags you need and order online or by phone, paying a week in advance either by cheque, cash or through the We Love Local website.

How much does it cost?

We sell the bag to you for £4 and you can sell the bag for any price you like, choosing to keep as much of the profit as you wish to use for school fundraising or profitable donations. Our only requirement is that the money is used for not-for-profit purposes.

We think a suitable selling price is about £5-£6.

What's in the bag?

A typical bag will weigh at least 3kg and will always contain 5 different varieties of locally-grown organic & non-organic vegetables. We will try to supply a mixture of kitchen basics like potatoes, carrots & onions along with some field vegetables, leafy greens and salad vegetables.

We source our vegetables from farmers across the south east, though we buy Sussex vegetables wherever possible. We choose growers who are organic, or who use natural methods of pest control.

An example bag might contain:
